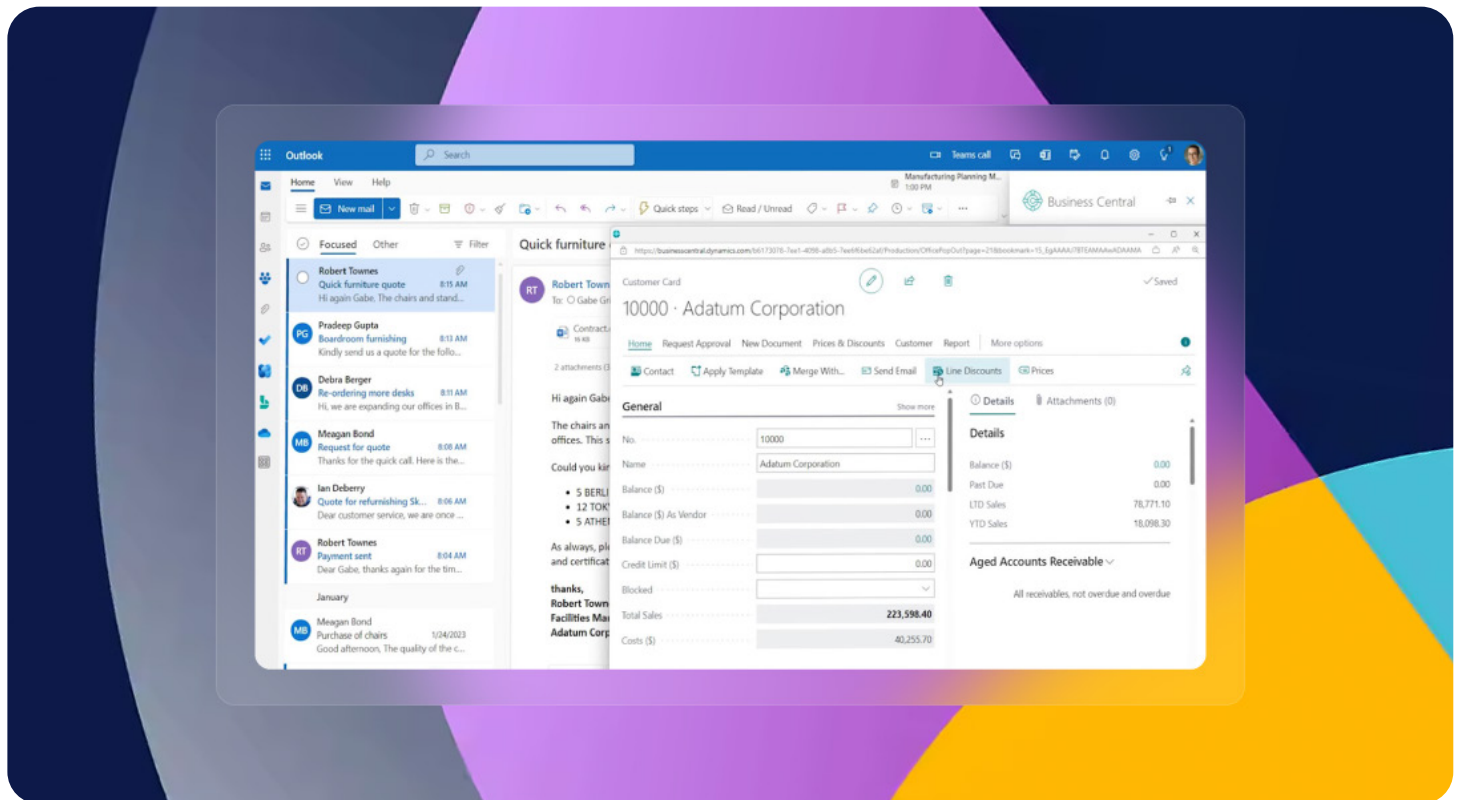

Set up customers or vendors, create quotes, submit invoices, and more from within Outlook so you can focus on the task at hand.

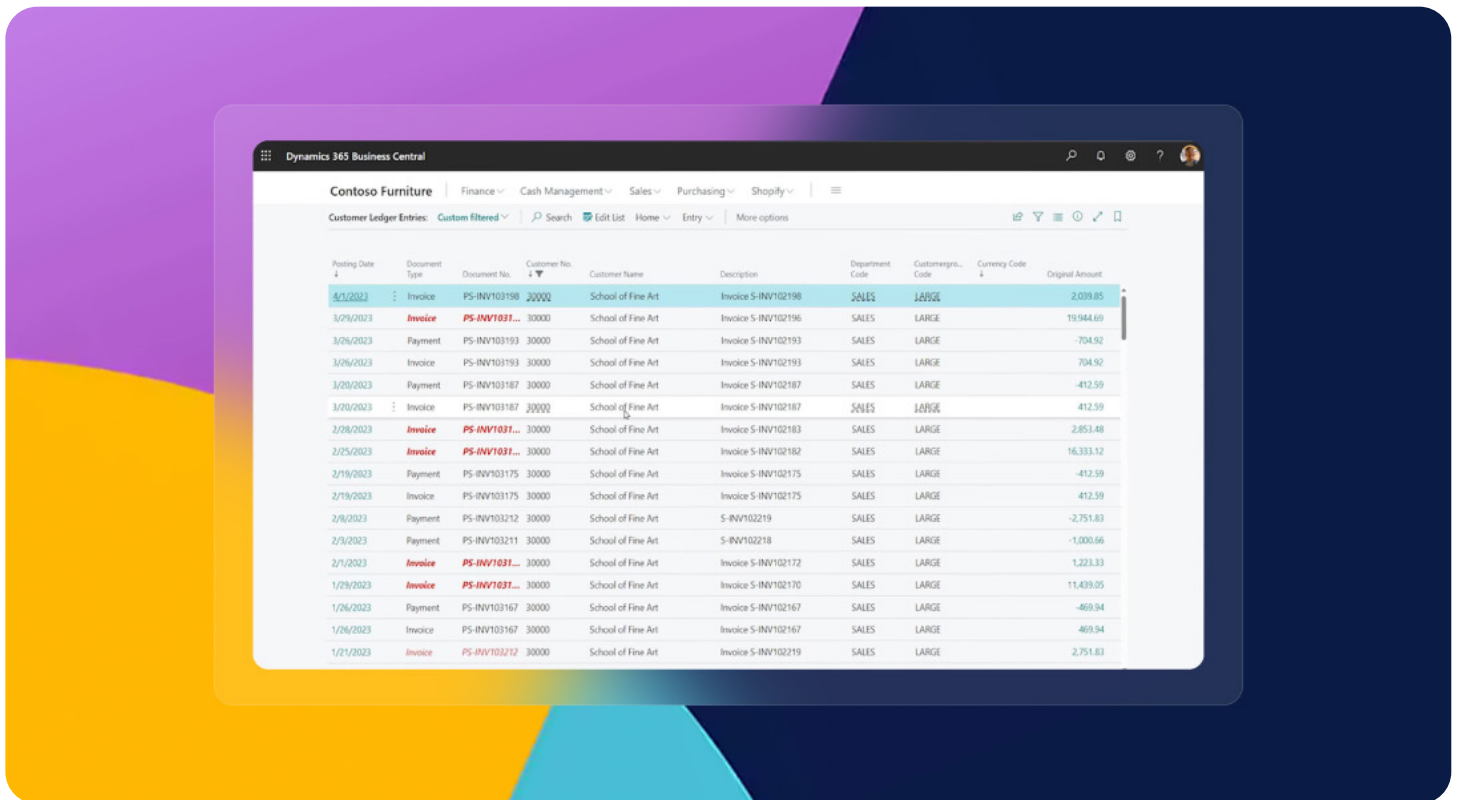
✓ Try this

When reading a customer email in Outlook, select the Business Central icon to open *Contact Insights*. From the side panel, create a new sales quote and choose *Attach*. Business Central assists in composing a reply that includes a PDF attachment of the quote using your company's preferred template.

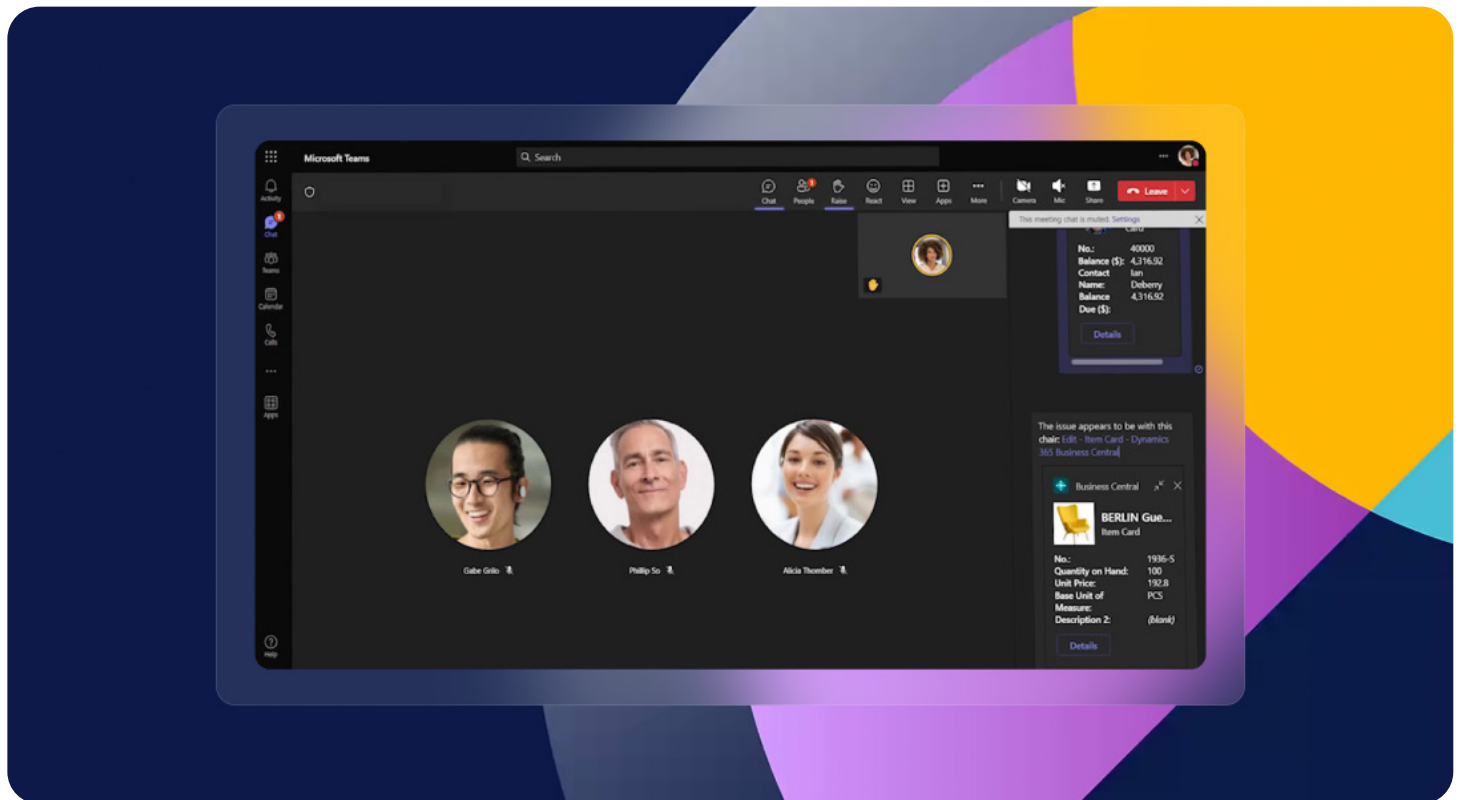
✓ Try this

After initiating a new budget for your ledger accounts in Business Central, select *Export to Excel*. Then, work together in Teams to collaborate and co-author in real time during a Teams meeting. Once budgeting is complete, import the data back into Business Central to begin comparing it with your general ledger actuals.
