




## Streamline task management





## Enable shift management


Shift management can elude many deskless workers because they can lack the tools and technology to take control

## Easily clock in and out


Allow deskless workers to clock in or out, no matter their device, with location detection and digital tracking sheets to ensure accurate time and attendance accounting






